Requirements

The Student Ambassador Program is an exceptional opportunity for students to interact with renowned international designers and technicians who are attending the annual conference. Three student members will each be paired with three visiting international guests with similar areas of focus to encourage international networking between student designer/technicians and our global colleagues. Student members will be chosen for this honor in Fort Lauderdale based on their fields of study, compelling application, and letter of recommendation from a mentor.

Entry requirements

- Must be a USITT Student member
- Deadline: **January 15, 2018**
- Must agree to attend the Ft. Lauderdale Conference for the full conference period

- Selected Ambassadors will be notified by January 31, 2018

Application

1. Your contact information
2. Name of mentor/instructor
3. Written narrative of Interest (300-500 words)
 - a. Why are you seeking this opportunity?
 - b. Which international guest would you like to meet?
 - c. How could your studies be enriched by this opportunity?
4. Letter of recommendation from mentor
5. Submit at least three questions you would like to ask your prospective guest.
6. Resume
7. Samples of your work
 - a. You can upload 10 samples of your work (photos, drawings, and renderings) or
 - b. You can provide your website url

Winners will be announced by January 31, 2018. If you are accepted into the Student Ambassadors Program you will receive free conference registration and join in a luncheon with the three international guests.
